

This Week at Helen Keller Middle School

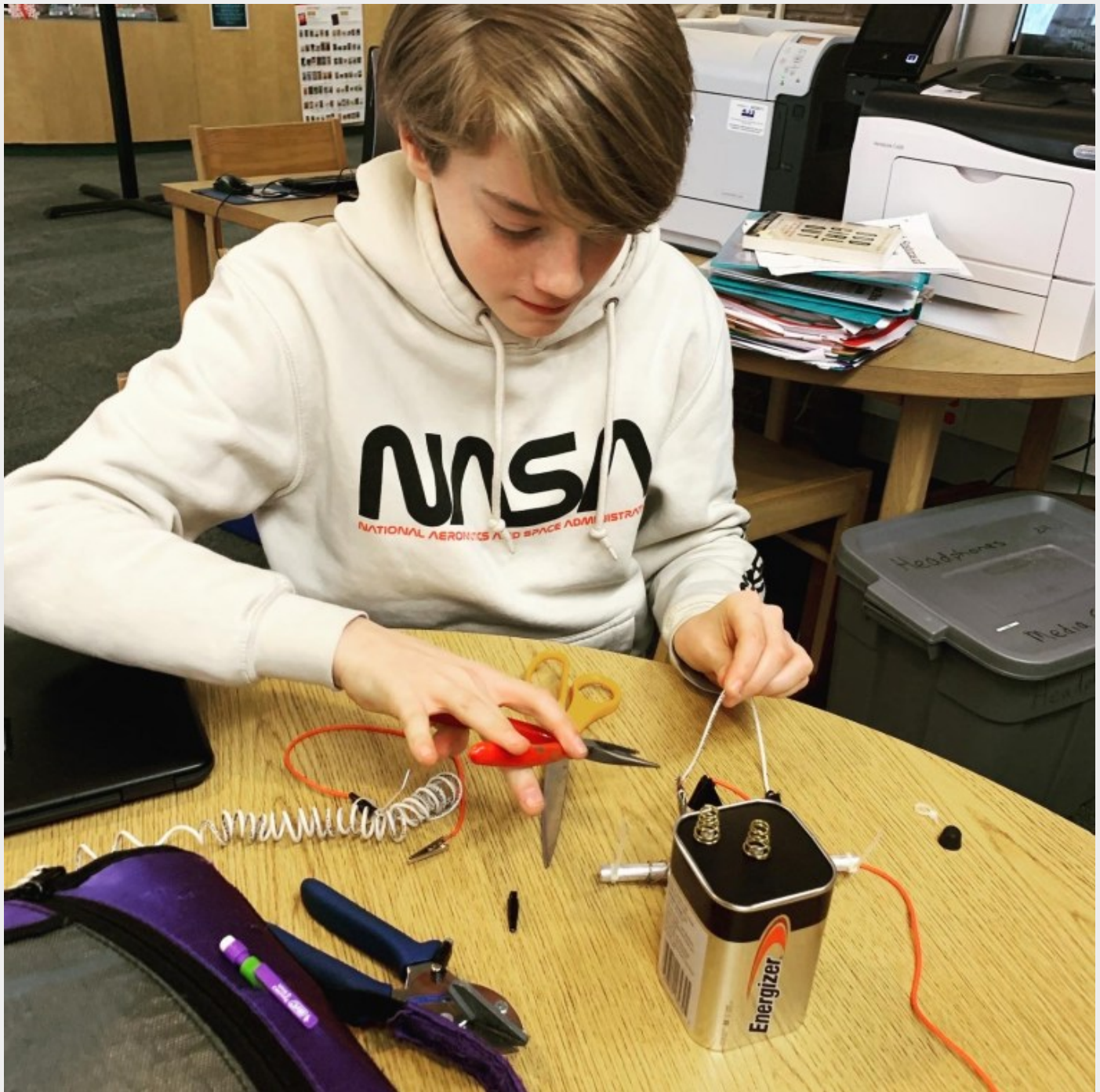


Each Friday afternoon, Helen Keller Middle School parents receive a handful of pictures in their email inboxes.
