

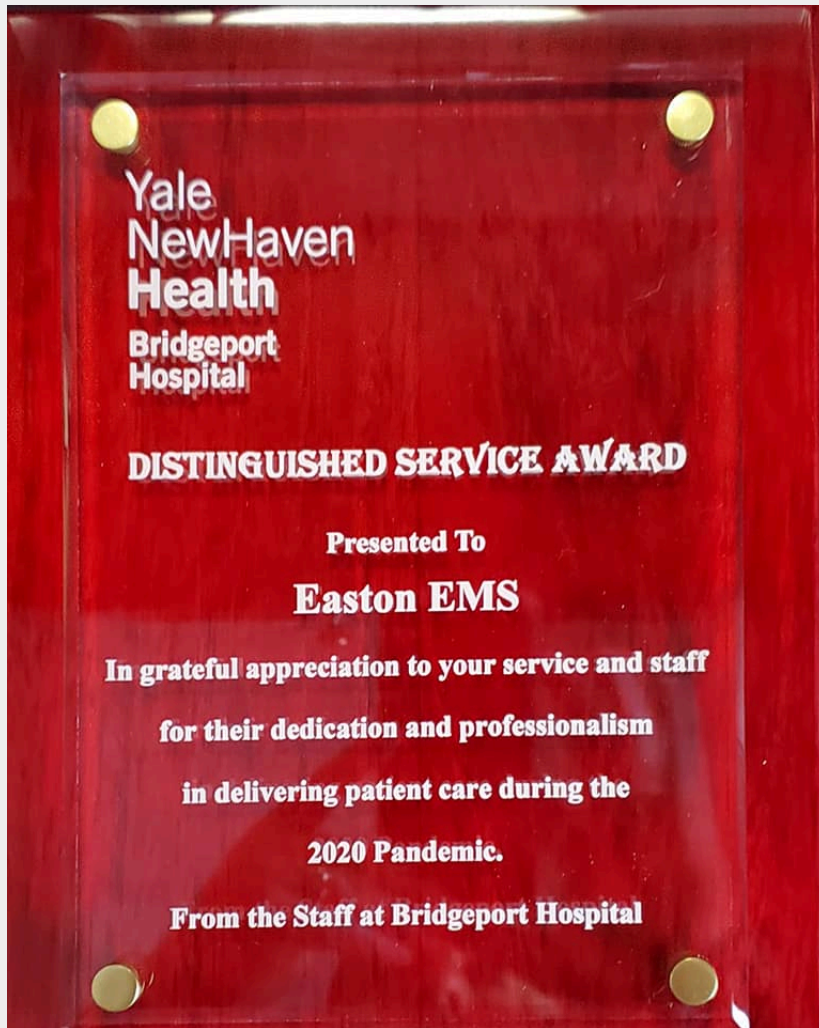
Many Groups Honor Easton EMS
