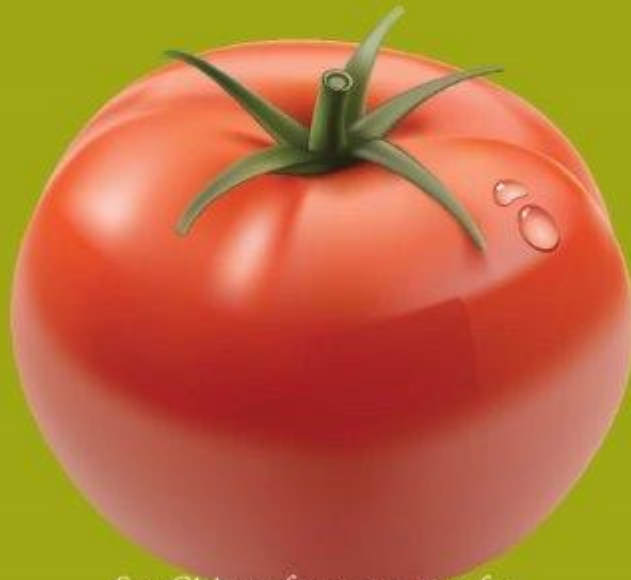
Locally sourced produce for CFE Cookbook
