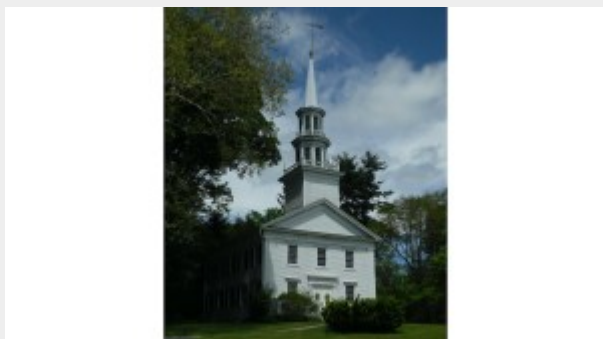


Church Community in the Midst of a World Pandemic

Pineapple Lemonade

Ingredients:

1 cup Country Time Lemonade Mix

3 cups cold water

1 can (46 oz.) chilled pineapple juice

2 cans Sprite

Directions:

Combine lemonade mix with water. Mix until dissolved.

Add pineapple juice and Sprite

Serve over ice.
