

New Officer Joins Easton Police Department



Easton Police Commission Chairman Richard Colangelo swore in a new officer, Luis Rodriguez, on Jan.10; he is the newest member of Easton's Police Department and brings a significant skill set to the department and the town.

According to a department press release, Rodriguez, 22, joined the Waterbury Police Department where he graduated from their police academy in 2020. He entered Easton's Emergency Medical Services in 2019 and is currently a state-certified Emergency Medical Technician.
