Covid hospitalizations are creeping up with the new variant taking over. The increase in hospitalizations suggests that a few more people are getting sicker from this. Still, it is difficult to know where this current wave is going.

At next week's Board of Selectmen meeting on July 21st, we will discuss South Park Avenue and the conservation easement. While most of it is done, we will be discussing the specific conditions of "passive recreation" on the property. The only remaining piece is the division of the property with the New England Prayer Center which is still being discussed with representatives of the petitioners and the prayer center.
